To make it clear, please split the abstract into five main components:

- ✓ Context/Purpose: One to two sentences to emphasize the relevancy of the targeted topic. Please indicate how did you apprehend this topic and what did you add to the existing knowledge?
- ✓ Methods: One to two sentences to precise what methods did you use to collect your data. What computer software did you use to process your data?
- ✓ Results: Three to four sentences to emphasize the main findings of your research work.
- Discussion/Interpretation: Three to four sentences to interpret your results and discuss your findings.
- ✓ Conclusion: One to two sentences to wrap up the main findings and the relevancy of your work. **Keywords:** First Keyword, Second Keyword, Third Keyword, Fourth Keyword, Fifth Keyword (Please add, at more, 5 keywords that should be written in the italic font character: times new roman, size 9).

1 Introduction (The section title should be written in bold font character: Times New Roman, size 12)

The introduction should be concise and address the overall theme. Authors should point to the aspect cleared through their research and suggest some hypotheses that would be discussed in the heading section. The last sentence should unravel the goal of the study. The paragraphs should be justified on the page and written in the Font character: Times New Roman, size 10.

This section should be composed of one single short indented paragraph, presenting the methods/materials, the legal framework, the geological setting, or.....The paragraphs should be justified on the page and written in the Font character: Times New Roman, size 10.

Results (The section title should be written in bold font character: Times New Roman, size 12)

The Results Section should be justified on the page and written in the font character: times new roman, size 11. Depending on how the extended abstract is created, this section may be broken up into two to three subsections at more. The subsections should be composed into concise indented paragraphs. Within this section, you should present your findings and results. Results interpretations and comments should be included within the Discussion Section.




Fig. 1. The figure caption should be placed below the illustration.

All **equations** must be readable, set on a separate line, and numbered correctly with the equation number aligned to the right margin.

5 Conclusions (The section title should be written in bold font character: Times New Roman, size 12)

The conclusion should wrap up, in four to five sentences, your main findings and the relevancy of your research works. The Conclusion Section should be justified on the page and written in the font character: Times New Roman, size 10). The conclusion should be summarized in one indented paragraph!

References (The subtitle should be written in bold font character: Times New Roman, size 11).

The references should be cited in the text by the author/authors and the year of publication between parenthesis, using the font character: Times New Roman, size 11. Within the text solely the last author's name should be mentioned. If the reference was created by (i) one author add between parenthesis (Author, Year); (ii) two authors add between parenthesis (first Author and second Author, Year); (iii) more than two authors add between parenthesis (First author et al., Year). Please find below sample references for Journal Papers, Books, Edited Books, and Electronic Media that should be formatted in the font character: Times New Roman, size 11.
